Recently, my favorite garden tool—scissor-like shears—broke into pieces. It had seen tough duty over the last 20 years, so its demise was sad but not entirely unexpected. I'm still hunting for a replacement. If you care for your quality tools with regular cleaning, sharpening, and storage, as well as using them for their intended purpose, they should last for a good long time. For cleaning, after each use, spray off dirt and grit and allow to dry. You may also need to disinfect your tools and apply oil to metal surfaces to keep them from rusting.
